Through My Window Wall Hanging by Karen Snyder - Studio Anna Lena

Cutting:

House *lena-c-5285 black/white* 1) 16-1/2" x 20"

Sky *lena-c-5279 white/black* 2) 8-1/2" squares

Border *lena-c-5278 black/white* 2) 3-1/2" x 20" and 2) 3-1/2" x 23"

Flange *super white* 2)1" x 20" and 2) 1" 16-1/2"

Panel *lena-c-5275 white/black* 1 panel cut into 8" squares

Back lena-c-5283 white/black 1) 26" x 30"

Binding *super black* 2) 2-1/4" strips



Sewing:

- 1. Prepare the monthly window squares. You may color them, stitch them or leave them plain. Press under a scant 1/4" on all sides. Hold in place with a fusible tape like Steam-A-Seam or stitch around the block.
- 2. Mark a diagonal line on one 8-1/2" square. Place it on one corner of the 16-1/2" x 20" rectangle. Sew on marked line. Trim, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press open. Repeat with remaining square to make the peak of the roof.
- 3. Fold the strips for the flange in half lengthwise and press. Using a scant 1/4" seam, add a flange to each long side of the house, then to the top and bottom.
- 4. Add a border strip to the top and bottom, then to each side.
- 5. Layer the top, batting and backing. Quilt and bind.
- 6. Display the monthly block windows on your wall hanging and enjoy!
